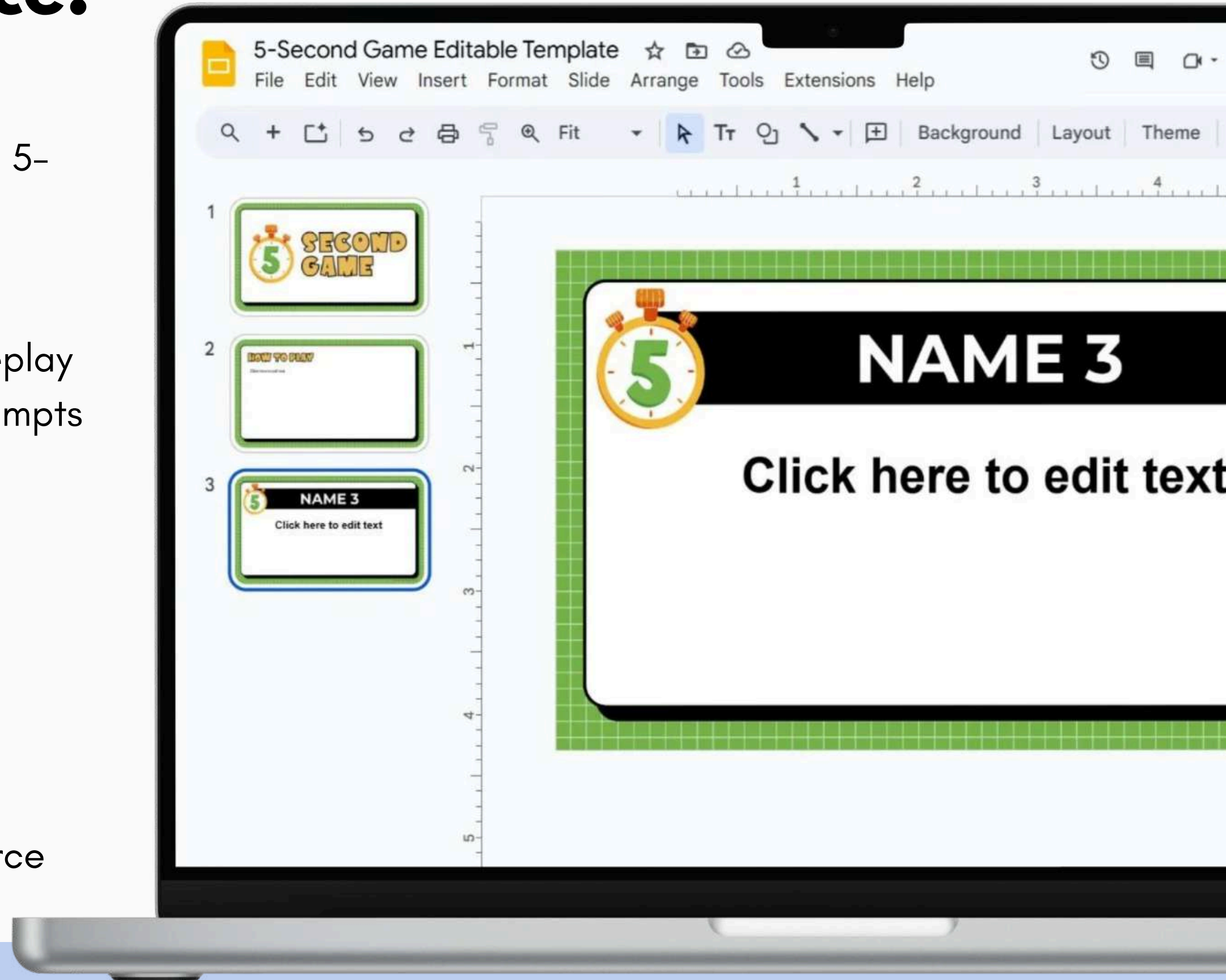

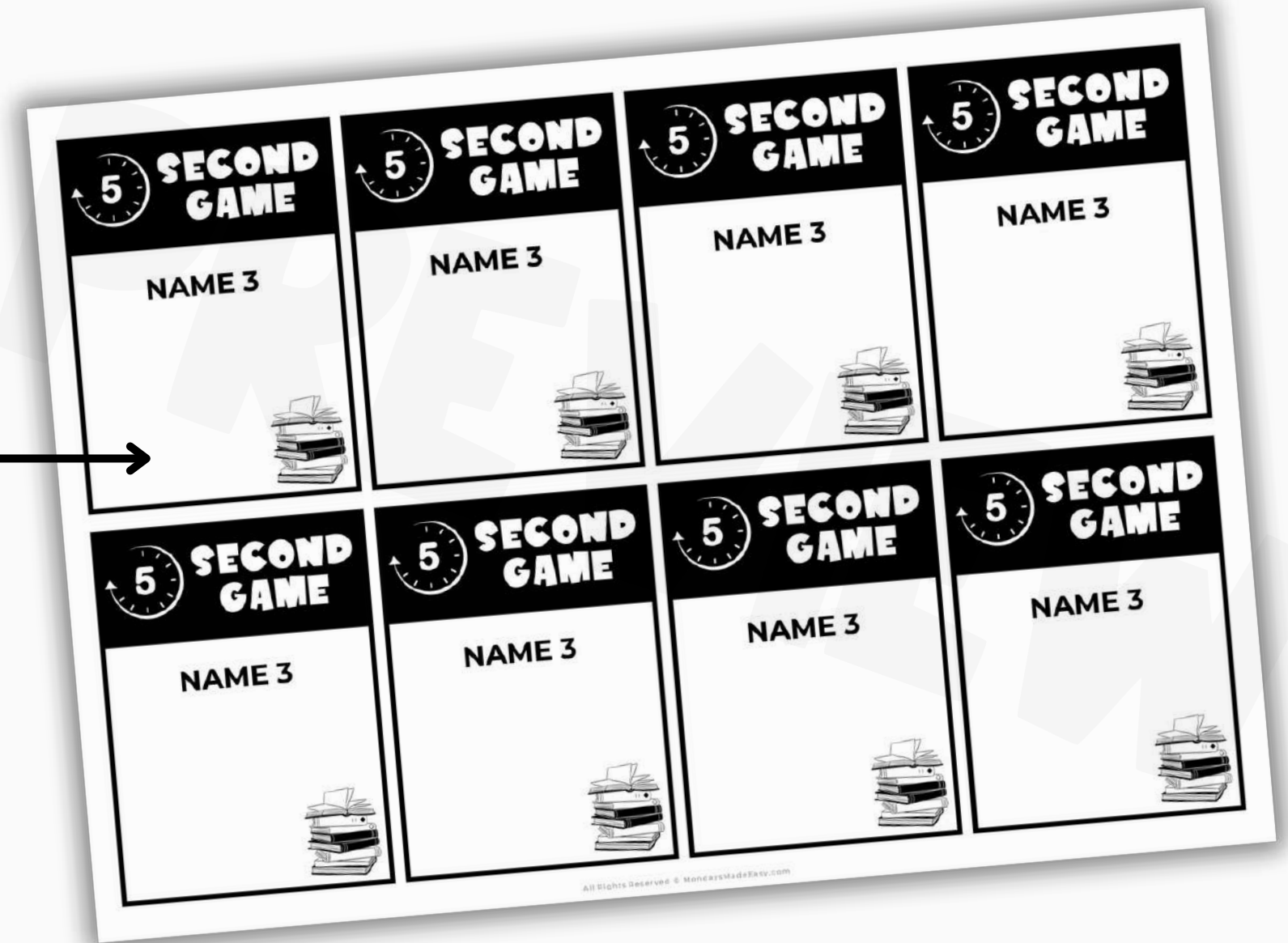
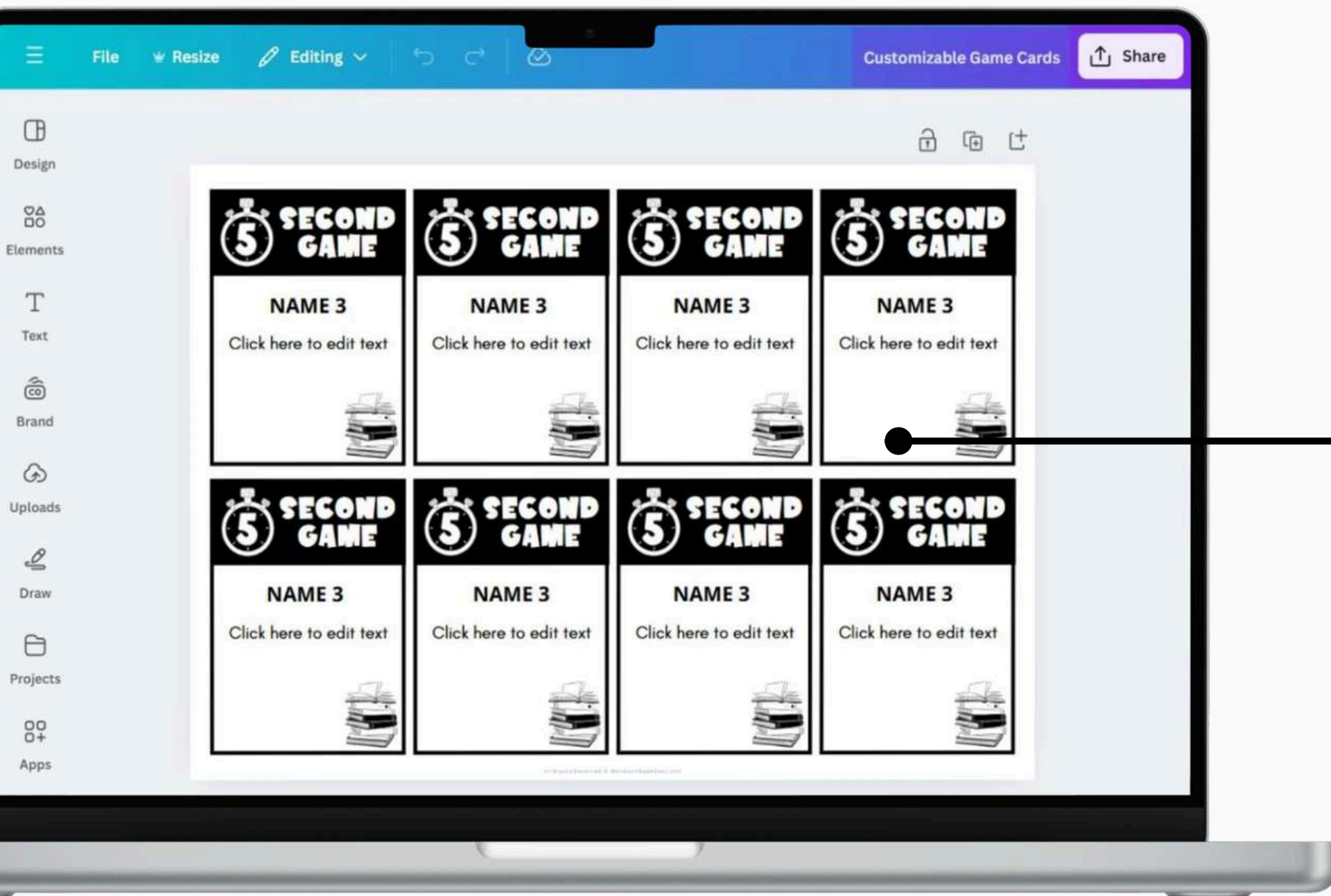
**HOW TO PLAY**

- 1. Pick a Card & Read the Prompt**
  - The player to the left of the Responder draws a card and reads the prompt.
- 2. Think Fast & Answer**
  - The Responder has 5 seconds to name three things that fit the category. No pauses or repeats!
- 3. Earn Points or Pass the Turn**
  - Three correct answers earn one point. If they fail, the turn moves to the next player with a new card.
- 4. Play Fair & Finish Strong**
  - Inappropriate answers may result in a penalty (point deduction or skipped turn).
  - The player with the most points at the end wins!
